RECIPE AND SCHEDULE

MARRY ME CHICKEN

Ingredients: 4 boneless, skinless chicken breasts

1 tsp salt, 1/2 tsp. black pepper, 2 tbsps. olive oil, 1 tbsp. butter,

3 garlic cloves, 1tsp. Italian seasoning, 1/2 tsp. red pepper flakes,

3/4 cup of chicken broth, 1/2 cup of heavy cream, 1/3 cup parmesan cheese,

1/4 cup basil.

<u>Directions:</u> Heat oven 375 degrees, sprinkle chicken with salt & pepper. Heat a skillet over medium heat and add the oil and butter. When the butter is melted, add the chicken breasts and sear 3-4 minutes each side until golden brown. Remove and cover chicken with foil. Reduce the skillet heat to low and add the garlic, Italian seasoning, red pepper flakes. Sauté' for 1 minute and then add chicken broth and stir. Then whisk in the heavy cream, add sun dried tomatoes, and parmesan cheese. Simmer for two minutes. Return the chicken back to the pan, spoon sauce over the chicken and place the pan in the oven to bake for 15 min. Internal temperature of chicken should be 165 degrees. Remove, top with basil and serve.
