RECIPE AND SCHEDULE

CHICKEN PARM PASTA BAKE

Chicken Parm Pasta— Ingredients Kosher salt, 12 oz. store-bought cooked frozen breaded chicken cutlets, 1 lb. cavatappi or other short pasta, 1 Tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil, 1 small yellow onion, finely chopped 2 garlic cloves, finely chopped 4 cups store-bought or homemade marinara sauce, 2 oz. Parmesan, finely grated (about 1 cup), divided, plus more for serving 3/4 cup shredded mozzarella, Freshly ground black pepper, Torn fresh basil, for serving.

Directions- Step 1 Cook frozen chicken according to package instructions. Let cool, then cut crosswise into strips. Step 2 Arrange a rack in center of oven; preheat to 400°. In a large pot of boiling salted water, cook pasta, stirring occasionally, until al dente according to package directions. Drain. Step 3 Meanwhile, in a large ovenproof skillet over medium high heat, heat oil. Cook onion, stirring occasionally, until translucent, about 7 minutes. Add garlic and cook, stirring, until fragrant, around 1 minute more. Add marinara and 1 tsp. salt and bring to a low simmer. Step 4 Add pasta to skillet and stir to coat in sauce. Add 1/2 cup Parmesan and toss until melted. Top with 1/2 cup Parmesan, then sprinkle with mozzarella. Arrange chicken on top of mozzarella. Step 5 Bake chicken Parm pasta until cheese is melted and chicken is warmed through, 10 to 12 minutes.
