

**The minutes of the Reorganization Meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Saddle Brook held on January 4, 2022 at 7:00 PM at the Saddle Brook Senior Center, 8 Caldwell Avenue, Saddle Brook, NJ.**

Township Clerk Peter Lo Dico called the meeting to order.

Mr. Lo Dico congratulated Council President Mazzer and wished her a successful year.

The Township Clerk administered the oath of office to Council President Mazzer.

## COMMENTS

Council President Mazzer thanked her colleagues for their vote of confidence and thanked Councilwoman D'Arminio for an amazing job and said she was a tough act to follow. She said she was honored to serve as Council President.

Mayor White said we have a very special guest here tonight whom we want to honor and recognize. He introduced Mr. Anthony "Tony" Gatto and said Mr. Gatto has served our community for over fifty years, as a member of the Zoning Board for which he has served the last sixteen years, ending his term on December 31<sup>st</sup> of 2021. He also served five years on our Planning Board, and he continues to serve with the Saddle Brook Volunteer Fire Department. He has served with the fire department for 52 years, including a stint as the Assistant Chief and then as a chief from 1982 to 1983. The respect and admiration that he's earned from the members of the fire department is apparent in the show of support he has here from the members of the fire department.

The Mayor invited Mr. Gatto up and presented him with box and gavel in appreciation for his years of service and his dedication to the Township.

Mr. Gatto spoke briefly, saying it was a pleasure to be here and that joining the fire department was one of the best things he's ever done. He commended the members of the Zoning Board and expressed his appreciation for the mayors, council members and others he has served with.

Council President Mazzer congratulated Mr. Gatto and noted there is a memorial bench in Tri-Centennial Park in his name.

Councilman Gierak congratulated Mr. Gatto and thanked Councilwoman D'Arminio for her service as Council President and congratulated Council President Mazzer. He concluded by wishing everyone a Happy New Year.

Councilwoman D'Arminio thanked Mr. Gatto for his service. She thanked the members of the Council and said it was her privilege to serve this past year. She congratulated Council President Mazzer and wished everyone a happy and healthy New Year and noted the Senior Center is closed for the month of January due to the spike in COVID cases, so there will be no activities this month. Regarding the new building she said she was at a meeting today, and the municipal complex is moving along. The electrical inspections have been done. Some of the walls are going up, and we are finalizing the low voltage electrical. We do have all of the materials; the plywood has been delivered, and we are going forward. She said if anybody has any questions feel free to call her at any time. We are moving forward and hopefully we will continue at this pace, and we should be done July 1<sup>st</sup>, maybe sooner.

Councilman Cimiluca expressed his congratulations and thanked Councilwoman D'Arminio for her service. He wished Council President Mazzer good luck and said it was a pleasure working with Mr. Gatto on the Zoning Board and said he brought the fireman's perspective to the Zoning Board. He thanked everyone who served last year and congratulated all the new nominees and wished everyone a Happy New Year.

Councilman Accomando echoed the sentiments of his colleagues and thanked Mr. Gatto and Council President Mazzer. He wished everyone a happy and prosperous New Year.

Council President Mazzer invited Chief Jason Sibani of the fire department to say a few words. Chief Sibani wished everyone a Happy New Year and thanked Mr. Gatto for his service.

Mayor White congratulated Mr. Gatto and thanked him for his years of dedicated service. He thanked Councilwoman D'Arminio for her service as Council President and for taking a leading role with the construction at the new municipal complex, saying she has put a great deal of time and effort into it. He congratulated Council President Mazzer and thanked the entire council for their commitment and dedication to the residents of Saddle Brook.

Mayor White said it's been another challenging year with COVID and hopefully 2022 will be better though we are not off to the best start. He noted he would skip the COVID update this evening but planned to do a video briefing for the residents shortly. He said he was very proud of this community and said the residents have been very good and compliant and have shown a lot of care and compassion towards others and have worked together in the fight to get rid of this virus.

He said the new municipal building project is coming along very nicely. We are right on schedule and on budget. He noted residents can check on the town website where there is a section dedicated to the new complex with photos and status reports on the work done thus far. Every week or so we put up new photos and a new report.

The Mayor said we completed a successful road resurfacing program. We finished four roads from the 2020 program and all seven from 2021, so eleven roads were done. We ended up bonding over \$2 million, and we received \$101,000 Community Block Grant funds for Albany Street, which was one of those streets that was paved. This year we are going to do it again, and hopefully we will get five or six roads done. He noted we received the following grants including \$200,000 from New Jersey Transit to pave Mayhill Street from the Route 80 Bridge to Market Street. We already paved the first half. These funds were approved, but that work will probably be done in 2022. We also received \$150,000 in Community Block Grant Funds for handicapped accessible improvements for the new municipal complex. We also got \$140,000 from the New Jersey Attorney General for body worn cameras for our police department. Every year we also get an annual recycling \$23,000 for Clean Communities. This grant money helps defray the cost of things and the increase in taxes.

Mayor White said he was very happy with the Community Partnership Committee and said they do a lot of work with the school district, the churches and all the businesses to assist our residents. He noted that ACME, Wal\*Mart, Dollar General, Spencer Savings, Ferraro Spine and Rehab, and Jason Mazzer Plumbing all contribute a lot to that committee and donate food and money to certain causes. Also the Women's Club of Saddle Brook has two members that come to all our meetings. He said they do a fantastic job.

He noted the Flood Committee, for which Councilman Gierak is the liaison, has been working on flood prevention measures and working with our flood plain manager on the FEMA Community Rating System, which provides a reduction in flood insurance premiums to residents in the flood zone. Just recently the Passaic Valley Sewer commission cleaned out trees and other natural debris from the Saddle River from the Red Mill in Paramus all the way to Essex Street in Lodi. Pete and I and Councilman Gierak met with representatives from Lodi, Rochelle Park and Wallington to talk about what's been going on after Ida and what we can do to band together to hopefully get something done and try to rattle some cages down in Trenton and the federal government. We've been recognizing and equipping our emergency responders. We hired five new police officers and promoted five individuals, three sergeants and two lieutenants. For the police department we purchased new computers, and we're going to be putting in a new radio system. The volunteer fire department has received, thanks to outgoing Fire Chief Polizzotti, about \$20,000 in grant funds for equipment. Engine 1 just received their new rescue truck that we ordered last year. We are trying to help the

volunteer ambulance corps recruit new members. Now is the time to get involved because they are short of personnel.

Mayor White said we brought back all of our events and activities that were cancelled in 2020 due to COVID. It was nice to celebrate again with our residents. We want to begin this summer hosting concerts. Councilman Cimiluca has been working with rec director Andy Gallo on that, so I'm hoping that we can reschedule a couple of them in the summer.

The Mayor said we're also on the way to receiving immunity and taking steps forward to meet our Mount Laurel obligation in regard to affordable housing which is something that we have to do and are required to do. We are moving forward with that. I'm very proud of what we've been able to accomplish this year, and we want to keep moving Saddle Brook forward. He concluded by wishing everyone a happy healthy New Year.

Mr. Lo Dico thanked Mr. Gatto for his years of service and expressed his respect for the volunteers and what they do.

Council President Mazzer asked for a brief intermission at this time. The meeting continued after a short break.

**Delinquent Taxes**

**WHEREAS**, NJSA 54:4-67 permits the governing body of each municipality to fix the rate of interest to be charged for nonpayment of taxes or assessments subject to any abatement or discount for the late payment of taxes as provided by law: and

**WHEREAS**, NJSA 54:4-67 has been amended to permit the fixing of said rate of 8% per annum on the first \$1,500.00 of the delinquency and 18% per annum on any amount in excess of \$1,500.00 and allows an additional penalty of 6% be collected against a delinquency prior to the end of the calendar year;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Saddle Brook, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to charge 8% per annum on the first \$1,500.00 of taxes becoming delinquent after due date and 18% per annum on any amount of taxes in excess of \$1,500.00 becoming delinquent after due date and if a delinquency is in excess of \$10,000.00 and remains in arrears beyond December 31st, and additional penalty of 6% shall be charged against the delinquency.
2. Effective January 1, 2022, there will be a ten day grace period of quarterly tax payments made by cash, check, or money order.
3. Any payments not made in accordance with paragraph two of this resolution shall be charged interest from the due date as set forth in paragraph one of this resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the penalty interest will be charged at the rate of 18% per annum on all delinquent water charges in excess of \$1,500.00 to be calculated from the date of billing until the date of actual payment, unless the water charges are paid during the first 30 days of the billing period or on the first business day thereafter if the office of the Treasurer is closed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that penalty interest rate on water charges shall revert to 18% per annum from the first day of the billing unless the water charges are in excess of \$1,500.00 for the same period are paid the first 30 days of the billing.
