The following is a list of specific steps taken by the township to combat the rodent problem:

1. The health inspector and property maintenance officer are dispatched to all rodent sighting complaints to investigate and locate the source and potential cause.
2. A pest control company has been hired to inspect all township properties and treat them if necessary.
3. A staff member has been assigned to manage, track, and follow up on all rodent complaints.
4. Additional staff members have been assigned to help enforce property maintenance and health regulations.
5. Township ordinances are being reviewed and amended where necessary to address the issue. For instance, adjustments are being made to building permits, garbage collection, and wildlife feeding.
6. The township collaborates with a dedicated group of residents committed to resolving the problem.
7. Other municipalities facing similar challenges have been contacted to learn about their approaches to problem-solving.
8. Rodent and pest control notices have been posted on the township website and Facebook page to request the public's assistance in mitigating the problem.
