The following is a list of specific steps taken by the township to combat the rodent problem:

- 1. The health inspector and property maintenance officer are dispatched to all rodent sighting complaints to investigate and locate the source and potential cause.
- 2. A pest control company has been hired to inspect all township properties and treat them if necessary.
- 3. A staff member has been assigned to manage, track, and follow up on all rodent complaints.
- 4. Additional staff members have been assigned to help enforce property maintenance and health regulations.
- 5. Township ordinances are being reviewed and amended where necessary to address the issue. For instance, adjustments are being made to building permits, garbage collection, and wildlife feeding.
- 6. The township collaborates with a dedicated group of residents committed to resolving the problem.
- 7. Other municipalities facing similar challenges have been contacted to learn about their approaches to problem-solving.
- 8. Rodent and pest control notices have been posted on the township website and Facebook page to request the public's assistance in mitigating the problem.
